

BRD BATH WITH

Read all instructions carefully before assembling and using this bird bath. Retain them for future reference and if you are passing this product to a third party, always make sure this documentation is included.

Intended Use

This product is intended as an outdoor bird bath and feeder for wild birds. This item is only designed for private use, not for commercial use.

Safety Information

- Keep children away during the assembly of the bird feeding table.
- Product contains small parts- choking hazard!
- This product is not a toy. Children should not play with this product.
- Do not climb on this bird feeding table.
- Regularly inspect this product for damage and wear. Check connections and joints and tighten all the fittings if necessary. Do not use if damaged, unstable or unsafe.
- This bird feeding table should be installed on stable, level and horizontal surface.
- Choose the location away from predators and large animals.

Hygiene

- Monitor your food supply carefully. Reduce the amount of food if it takes days to clear.
- Keep the surrounding areas clean and free from droppings or mouldy food.
- Clean the feeder regularly, follow the cleaning instructions below.
- ALWAYS wear disposable gloves when filling, cleaning or moving bird feeders. Wash your hands immediately.
- Do not let children play with or touch the bird feeders.

Installation and Location Information

- Install the bird feeding table on a solid, stable and horizontal surface away from foot traffic and children play areas.
- Ensure the feeder is secure to prevent it from falling. Secure to the ground in a best possible way depending on the surface and location. On grass, the feeder can be secured with ground pegs - Note these are not included with this set and must be purchased separately.
- Relocate the feeder from time to time to help to deter predators.

Cleaning, storage and maintenance

- To keep wild birds healthy, clean the bird feeding table regularly.
- Clean the surfaces with sligthly dampened, lint-free cloth.
- In the event of severe soiling use mild cleaning solution or desinfectant, ensure that all stubborn dirt is removed.
- To prevent mould, dry the product with a dry cloth after cleaning with liquids.
- Allow the feeding table to dry completely before storage to avoid mould or damage. Store this item in a dry, dust-free place away from direct sunlight or other sources of heat and away from traffic to avoid the product becoming a tripping hazard.




Screw the lower stem (B) onto the base (A).



Screw the upper stem (B) onto the lower stem.




Assemble the table support by screwing the arms (E) to the post (D) using 1x longer screw (1).



Assemble the feeding table as shown using 4x table sides, 1 x roof support and 8x small screws (3). Secure the sides from underneath with screws.



Fit the table support (assembled in step 3) to the underneath of feeding table using 3 x small screws (3).



Place the bird decoration in the centre of the feeding table.



Place the roof on top of the already assembled feeding table, put the top piece through the hole and secure with 1 x nut and washer (4) from underneath.



Secure the completed feeding table to the bird bath using 1 x bolt (2) and washer.



Screw the bird bath to the upper stem to complete the assembly of this bird bath. Place in desired location in your garden.
